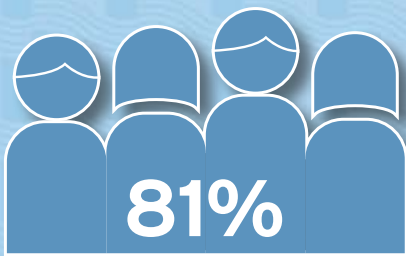


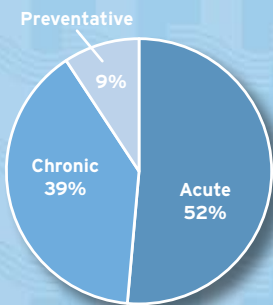

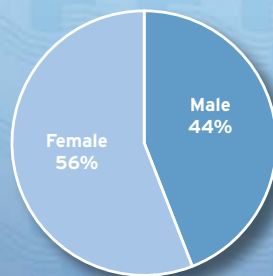

Patient Visit Need

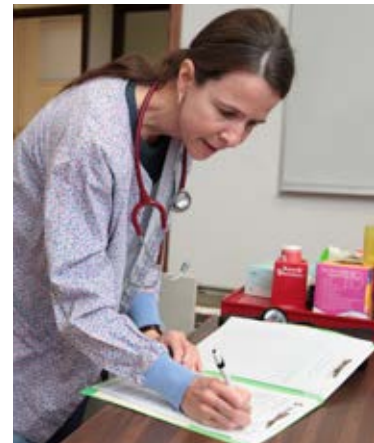


Patient Gender

THE NEED CONTINUES!

- Affordable Care Act Predictions Unmet:**
 The Federal Congressional Budget Office expects the number of people insured on state and federal exchanges to be **HALF** the number predicted (10M instead of 20M).
- Uninsured, Decreasing but not Eliminated:**
 US Census Bureau report for Iowa's uninsured rate is 6.2%, representing about 189,000 Iowans.
- Underinsured, a Growing Emergence:**
 Inadequate and/or unusable coverage that limits access due to unaffordable out-of-pocket co-pays/deductibles/premiums, covered service limitations and/or benefit caps.
- Access Barriers:**
 Continued challenges in access that have little to do with insurability, such as limitations in transportation, childcare, employment/lost wages, health insurance literacy and/or other determinants of health.

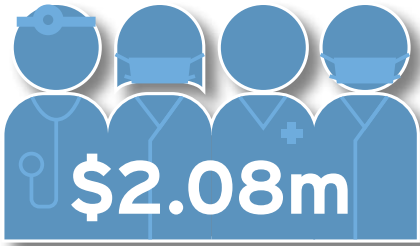

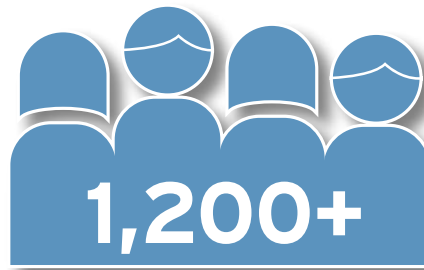

2015 Highlights



Over **\$2.08 Million Contribution** to Iowa's Healthcare Delivery System via charitable basic/acute, chronic, preventative and dental services.¹



More than **1,200 clinic volunteers** provided **22,162 hours** of care in **31 clinics** throughout Iowa



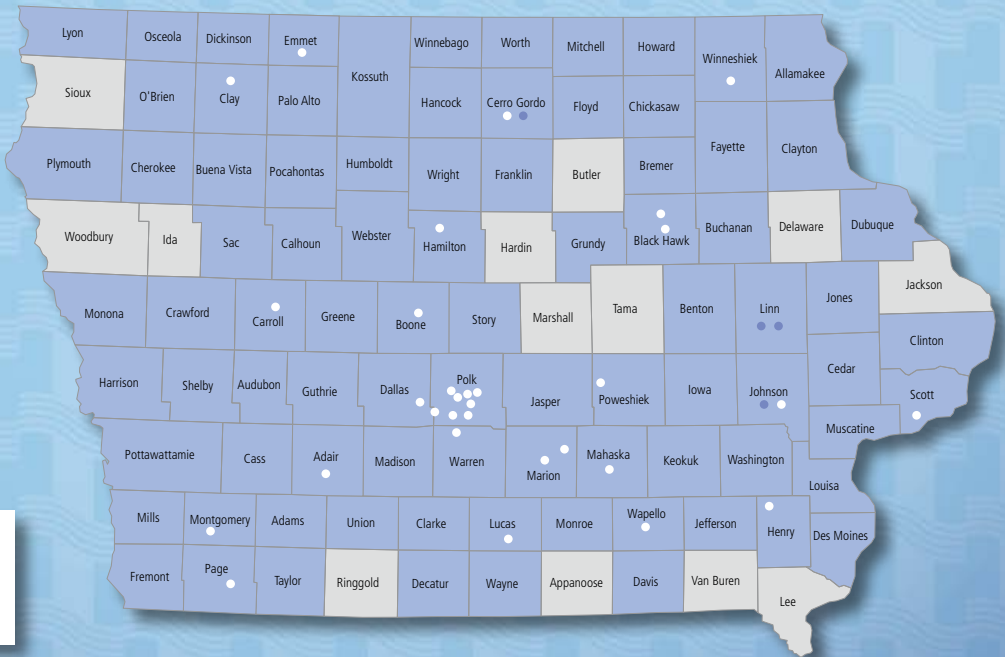
With average Emergency Room visit costs of \$2,168 per visit free clinics could be providing **\$12 Million in cost avoidance** for the State of Iowa.²



The State of Iowa invests \$348,322 in its free clinics - the Return on Investment yields **\$5 for every \$1 invested**.³

² 2013 National Institute of Health(NIH) study determined average ER visit cost of \$2,168 x 5,700 (half of the 2015 FCI patient visits) = \$12,357,600
³ 2015 FCI value of service \$2,087,418 - \$348,322 free clinic appropriation = 1,739,096/348,322 = 4.99
